

AUTHORS' GUIDE

Papers submitted to the 11th International Mineral Processing Symposium should be prepared as a MS Word document and sent to the Symposium Secretariat at imps2008@metu.edu.tr. The papers will be published as submitted. Therefore, the authors should make sure that the following instructions are fully obeyed.

Language:		The papers must be in English. Characters other than those used for scientific notations must be avoided.
Length:		The papers should be 6 pages long maximum, including figures, tables, etc.
PAGE SETUP	Paper Size:	The papers must be typed on a custom size paper with 16 cm width and 23.5 cm length.
	Margins:	Top: 2.5 cm, Bottom: 2.5 cm, Left: 1.5 cm, Right: 1.5 cm.
	Layout:	Section Start: New Page; Header: 1.25 cm and Footer: 1.25 cm from edge; Vertical Alignment: Top
COLUMNS:		1 column with 13 cm width.
FONT	Font:	Times New Roman.
	Style:	Title: Bold; Headings: Bold; Main text: Regular.
	Size:	Title: 12 points; the rest: 11 points.
	Color:	Black
PARAGRAPH	Alignment:	Left.
	Indentation:	The first paragraphs after a heading must start with no indentation. The other paragraphs after the first paragraph under the same heading should have 0.5 cm indentation from the left.
	Spacing:	Single line spacing should be used throughout. One 11 point line space between the title and authors; 11 point <i>one line</i> space between the first and second (group of) authors with different affiliations. Two 11 point two line space before a major heading and one 11 point one line space before a minor heading. No space is necessary if the headings start on the top of the page.
TABLES:		All tables should be center aligned. The captions should be typed over and left aligned with tables. Authors are urged to use the space for tables economically; multiple tables may be placed on one row or tables should be extended in the horizontal direction.
FIGURES:		All figures should be center aligned. The captions should be typed under and left aligned with figures. Authors are urged to also use the space for figures economically; multiple figures may be placed on one row. The color of the figures should be only black and gray.
REFERENCES:		References in the main text should be given in (Last Name, Year) style and listed alphabetically at the end of the paper.
