

The Title Should Be 12 Points, Title Case, Bold And Only One Line

ABSTRACT:

The abstract should be typed after two 11 point line spacing below the authors and not exceed 100 words.

Key words: A few key words descriptive of the paper should be typed here beneath the abstract after a one line spacing .

1. INTRODUCTION:

Major headings should be typed in uppercase. After a major or minor heading, the first paragraph should always be left justified and start without any indentation.

The following paragraphs under the same heading should start at a 0,5 cm indentation.

2. MATERIALS AND METHODS:

There should be a two line spacing between the last line of the previous paragraph and the major heading.

2.1. Minor Heading

Minor headings should be typed in title case. There should be one line spacing before a minor heading.

REFERENCES:

References should be listed in alphabetical order. There should be no line spacing between adjacent references. The first line of each reference should be left aligned, following lines should have a 0.5 cm indetation as given in the following examples. *Titles of papers and books should be in italic.*

Two references of the same authors and years should be given as in (Last Name(s), 2008a and 2008b).

Examples:

Journal Publications:

Last Name Author(1), Initials Author(1).; Last Name Author (2), Initials Author(2)., Year of publication, *Title of the paper*, The name of the journal, volume/issue, page.

Books:

Last Name Author(1), Initials Author(Author 1).; Last Name Author (2), Initials Author(2)., Year of publication, *Title of the book*, Publisher.

Proceedings:

Last Name Author(1), Initials Author(1).; Last Name Author (2), Initials Author(2)., Year of publication, *Title of the paper*, Title of the proceeding, Editors, Publisher.
